

Foal feed plan:

At birth

Pavo Colostrum

Colostrum is essential for the foal to take in within a few hours after birth.

When the mare is not giving (enough) colostrum, then use a colostrum replacer like Pavo Colostrum.



Pavo KickStart

Every foal can use some additional support. Pavo KickStart is an immunity paste for foals.

One package contains two syringes of which the first one should be given directly after the intake of the first colostrum. The second syringe should be given within the next 24 hours. Always give the full syringe, expect for really small ponies like Shetland ponies, in that case ½ syringe is enough.

Day 1

Additional feed or supplements:

Pavo Podo®Care

It is possible to start feeding Pavo Podo®Care as soon as your foal starts eating. This vitamin and mineral balancer offer the foal all the most important minerals that are needed for healthy bone development.

Daily feeding advice:

The feeding advice is the same for foals, growing horses and pregnant mares. Pony: 100 g | Horse: 200 g



From week 3

The basics: mare's milk & pasture grass

Additional feed or supplements:

From 3 weeks onwards, a foal will start to eat together with its mother in a playful manner and will thus already consume some grass, hay and concentrates. This is the time to slowly offer the foal its own bowl of foal pellets, muesli or balancer.

Month 4

Month 5

Additional feed or supplements:

Pavo Podo®Start

Small pellets for foals until a few weeks after weaning

Daily feeding advice:

Pony: 1,1 kg | Horse: 2,1 kg

Tip! Continue feeding Pavo Podo®Start until a few weeks after weaning. Switch then gradually to Pavo Podo®Grow (pellets) or Pavo Podo®Junior (muesli).



Tip! Continue feeding Pavo Podo®Start until a few weeks after weaning. Switch gradually to Pavo Podo®Grow (pellets) or Pavo Podo®Junior (muesli) then.

Daily feeding advice:

Pony: 1,1 kg | Horse: 2,1 kg

Tip! Does your foal not get a concentrates containing the Podo® concept like Pavo Podo®Start or Pavo Podo®Junior, or do you feed less than the recommended daily quantity? Then supplement it with Pavo Podo®Care, a special mineral balancer for foals, growing horses and pregnant mares.

Feeding advice:

Pony: 100g (50g in case Podo®-concentrate is fed less then recommended)

Horse: 200g (100g in case Podo®-concentrate is fed less then recommended)
